WHAT IS MARY'S MEALS?

Mary's Meals is a charity that does something very simple. It provides a daily meal for children that live in some of the poorest communities in the world when they come to school.

Our work started when our founder, Magnus, met a 14-year-old boy called Edward in Malawi during a terrible famine in 2002. Magnus asked Edward what his dreams were for his future. **Edward replied:**

"To have enough food to eat and to go to school one day."

Many children in countries like Malawi can't go to school because they do not have enough to eat and have to work to buy food instead. Without an education, millions of children – like Edward – are unable to achieve their dreams.

But thanks to Edward's words, Mary's Meals was born! Magnus decided to help children who were too hungry to come to school by providing a daily meal in between classes. That meant they could stop worrying about earning money or finding food and concentrate on learning.

We would love your school to join us and help those children to build better lives. It only costs 11¢ to provide one of the special school meals that are helping so many hungry children, so it doesn't take much to make a real difference!

Mary's Meals began feeding around **200 primary school children** in Malawi in 2002.

The offer of a daily meal encourages hungry children to come to school, where they receive a nutritious cup of porridge and the education they need to realize their dreams.

Volunteers from the community surrounding each school take turns to cook and serve the daily meals. This low-cost, community-based approach has allowed Mary's Meals to expand, reaching children on five continents.

Today, Mary's Meals provides more than 1.3 million children with a daily meal every day they attend school. Our vision is that every child receives a daily meal in their place of education.

There are currently 64 million more children like Edward who are out of school because of poverty and hunger.
